Welcome to Zurich and welcome to the 2024 UCI Cycling World Championships!

For the first time in the history of cycling, the world's elite para-cyclists and cyclists will compete on the same roads and cross the same finish line. A total of 66 UCI World Championship titles will be awarded over nine days of racing. And you can be part of it! I am delighted to be able to offer every cycling enthusiast the opportunity to be part of the World Championships.

There will be 2 public races. Cheering after the 27 km circuit - the centerpiece of the road race, the "City Race" or as the highlight of the time trial with a personal time, the "Legends Race". Always on the official, closed-off course, always over the finish line at Sechseläutenplatz.

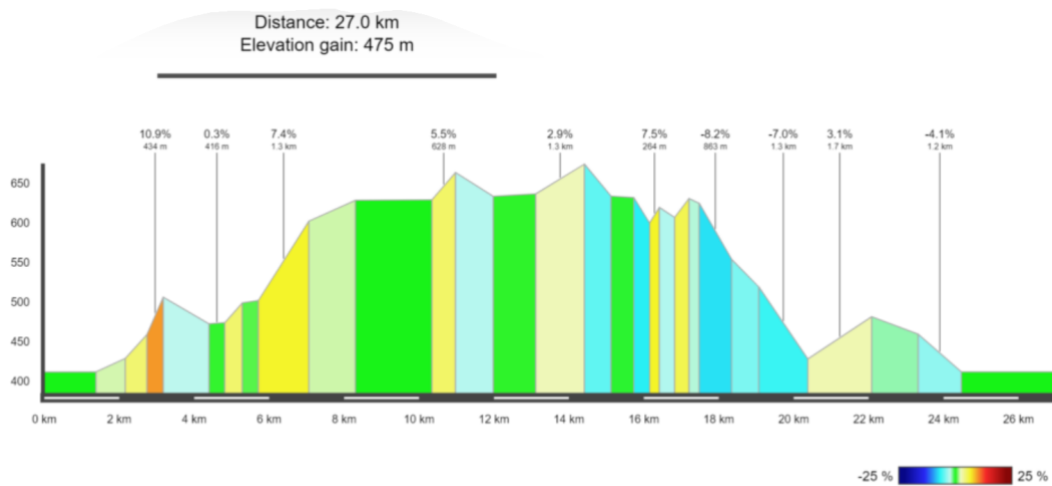

It will not be possible to register on site on the day of the event.

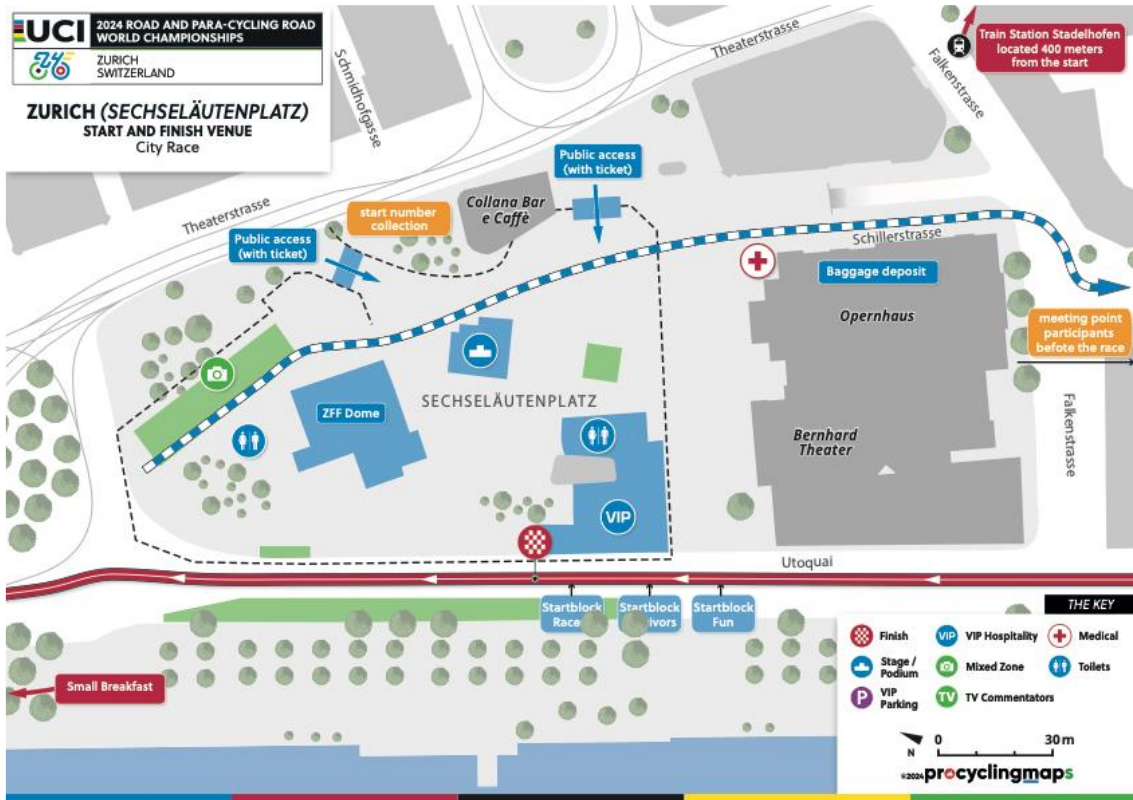

## 7. ARRIVAL

The start of the City Race is at Sechseläutenplatz in Zurich.

Please allow enough time for your journey.

Sechseläutenplatz is easy to reach by public transport. Stadelhofen railway station is right next to Sechseläutenplatz.

Your start ticket includes a ZVV ticket including bike for all zones on 29 September! When checking your public transport ticket, show your registration confirmation from Ticketmaster to the public transport staff.

## 9. STARTING BLOCKS

The City Race uses **gross start times** per starting block. This means that the race time for all participants in a starting block starts from the official start signal of their respective block, regardless of when they actually cross the start line.

There are three starting blocks with the following official gross starting times:

- **Block Racers:** 7:45 am
- **Block Survivors:** 7:48 a.m.
- **Block Fun:** 7:51 a.m.

The timekeeping for all participants in a starting block begins with the respective gross start time. Example: If you are in the *Survivors* starting block, your race time officially starts at 7:48 am, regardless of when you cross the start line.

## 10. START NUMBERS

Those who have received their start number at home can go straight to the start. Please be at the assembly point at Kreuzstrasse 5 at least 15 minutes before your start.

Those who registered after 8 September and did not receive a race number at home must collect their race number at the following location: Sechseläutenplatz Zurich (Ticketmaster ticket sales stand)



If for some reason you did not receive a race number at home, there are reserve race numbers available on site at the Ticketmaster sales stand at Sechseläutenplatz.

## 11. LUGGAGE, WHEELCHAIR AND PROSTHESIS STORAGE

During the City Race you have the option of depositing a small piece of luggage, a wheelchair or prostheses.

This service is free of charge. For security reasons, random baggage checks may be carried out. Please do not leave any valuables in your bag. Suitcases and large bags will not be accepted.

Your race number contains a voucher for a baggage, wheelchair and prosthesis drop-off. You can hand them in at [the Bürkliplatz](#).

Please attach the following voucher to your luggage, wheelchair or prosthesis.

! After the race, you can park your racing bike in the guarded ABUS Bike Parkings on Münsterhof, Limmatquai or General Guisan Quai and watch the men's elite race in a relaxed atmosphere. There are 100 bike spaces per car park. Supervision times are half an hour before and after the opening times of the fan zones.

## 12. Authorised bicycles

Only racing bikes are permitted for the City Race. Handlebar attachments of any kind (e.g. time trial, triathlon or aero handlebars) are prohibited. All bicycles must comply with UCI regulations. The bikes must weigh at least 6.8 kg without bottles and computer.

## 13. GIFT

Your start number contains a voucher for a gift. You will receive the gift at the finish at Sechseläutenplatz so that you do not have to deposit it or take it with you during the race.

## 14. RANKING LISTS

There will be the following categories:

- Para athletes
- Women
- Men

The first 3 in each category are asked to go to the Sechseläutenplatz entrance (meeting point at the Sechseläutenplatz sales stand) 15 minutes after the last participant crosses the finish line for a souvenir photo on the podium. The lucky ones will be notified via Datasport by text message.

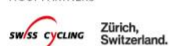
## 15. RESULTS

The timekeeping and the results are determined by electronic timekeeping with a timekeeping chip in your start number.

Please do not remove or damage the timing chip. If it is damaged, you may not receive a finishing time (and will therefore be marked as DNF in the results).

The results are published on the Datasport website.
